All six rotations diagrammed · P1-P6 = your serve order · rotate clockwise on side-out

The two rules

1. Rotate clockwise one zone ONLY when your team wins the serve back (side-out). The player rotating into zone 1 is your new server.
2. If your team keeps scoring on serve, nobody moves — the same player keeps serving.

Overlap rule cheat

At the moment of serve: stay on the correct side of your neighbors — front-row players in front of your back-row neighbor, and keep left-to-right order with the players beside you. Once the ball is served, go anywhere. Cue for kids: know your two neighbors, stay on the right side of them, then play.
